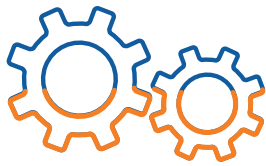

Paid summer Internship at Lozier prior to starting class.

Paid tuition for two-year program at NACC including textbooks, tools & toolbox.

A full-time Tool and Die or Maintenance position following completion of the program.

Deadline: Feb. 28, 2025

Applicants will be contacted regarding sponsorship selection approximately two weeks before Signing Day ceremony.

YOUR PART

- Start paid summer position two weeks after high school graduation until classes for fall semester begin.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Maintain responsible performance as a student. Suspension or probationary status would be grounds for dismissal of Sponsorship*.
- Commit to working for Lozier as a paid Tool and Die or Maintenance employee for two years following completion of the program.

**This is a binding commitment by the recipient and failure to complete the two years of employment will result in the recipient being obligated to repay the cost of tuition and books and to return tools and toolbox.
